All of the agencies and organizations that are included in this guide are here because they offer services or supports that relate to children and youth mental health and wellbeing.

All information in this Service Directory was obtained from 211 Alberta, informalberta.ca, and helpseeker.org, which are online databases that list information on community, health and social services all over Alberta.

While all of the resources, supports, and agencies listed here have been narrowed down for people between the ages of 12 and 17, some services and programs are for individuals outside of the 12 to 17 age range or outside of Alberta. Check with the agency to see what age groups or geographic jurisdictions they offer services to.
